

SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

DIPLOMA PRIMARY TEACHER EDUCATION TRAINING

Windle invites scholarship applications from untrained refugee and refugee returnee teachers currently residing in Jubaland for a diploma in primary teaching.

The scholarship is a UNHCR programme funded and implemented in partnership with Windle International Somalia (WISOM) with the goal to support access to certified Diploma Primary Teacher education training for Untrained Refugee and Refugee returnees' teachers in Jubaland, Somalia. The programme aims to improve the quality of education outcomes for the Refugee and Returnee learners in Jubaland through improved capacity and teaching skills with the overall impact of providing employment opportunities and enhancing durable solutions while contributing to the country's education inclusion focus. The course will be taken in Jubaland Teacher Training College for a period of 2 Years.

Criteria information

A. Scholarship Academic Level of Study.

Diploma in primary teacher education. Please note that the programme DOES NOT support undergraduates.

B. Qualification:

Every Applicant MUST:

1. **Recognized Refugee Status:** Be a holder of valid refugee status (having UNHCR protection document) or be a holder of valid return documents (Voluntary Repatriation Form)
2. **Academic Documents:** Have original and/ or certified academic documents from a recognized secondary school **with a minimum grade of C and above.**
3. Not currently under resettlement process or scholarship programme.
4. Ability to demonstrate financial need for education to pursue Diploma in Primary Teacher Education
5. Must be currently working as untrained teacher or is willing to be a teacher and remain in teaching for at least 2 Years after the graduation.
6. Applicants MUST attach copies of academic documents (certificates and transcripts where applicable) from a recognized academic institution, UNHCR Proof of Registration for refugees and UNHCR Voluntary repatriation form (VRF) for refugee returnees and Letter of confirmation from the school or Department of Higher Education at Ministry of Education, Culture and Higher Education Jubaland.
